Get help paying for college by submitting a Free Application for Federal Student Aid. To complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), you will need to go to the FAFSA website.

Make sure you have the following:

- Your Social Security Number
- Your Alien Registration Number (if you are not a U.S. citizen)
- Your most recent federal income tax returns, W-2s, and other records of money earned. (Note: You may be able to transfer your federal tax return information into your FAFSA using the IRS Data Retrieval Tool.)
- Bank statements and records of investments (if applicable)
- Records of untaxed income (if applicable)
- An FSA ID to sign electronically.
