



Student ID

Students will receive an Overland Student ID on Check-in Day at the beginning of the school year. Students who miss Check-in Day can get a Student ID in the Security Office.

Your ID will show your photo, name, grade level, school year, and student ID number. It will also indicate if you have paid the Activities Fee for discounted events.

Here's why you need to carry your ID at all times:

- check out materials from the Library
- some teachers ask to temporarily hold your ID while you are borrowing a laptop
- free admission to home games
- discounted admission to events such as the Talent Show, Homecoming, and Prom (discounts apply only with the Activities Stamp)
- discounted admission or free items in the community (movies, restaurants, etc.)
- verify that you are a student at Overland High School
